On Wednesday 19th April 2023, the Parish Council flag was flown at half mast and an evening service was held to mark 125 years since the Whitwick Mining Disaster of 1898.

Descendants of those affected by this local tragedy were amongst those who attended the service which included a number of heartfelt speeches, a wreath laying, performances by the Desford Colliery Band and a dedication of the newly completed memorial wall at Whitwick Park.
