

Eco-Park Approved

following a recent consultation with residents, plans to create an eco-park at the Hermitage Recreation Ground have now been agreed. The aim is to create an attractive visitor destination for families whilst increasing biodiversity in the area.

The project will include the installation of outdoor equipment, an activity trail and a 'tiny forest' with



planting of trees and fast-growing native woodland as well as the addition of footpaths and a footbridge to improve accessibility. Works are set to begin this autumn.
