You will need to meet the basic legal requirements to serve as a councillor, which include:

- Being at least 18 years of age on the date of co-option
- Living in the parish or within 4.8 km of the boundary
- Working or owning land/property within the parish

Anyone expressing an interest will be invited to attend the next meeting of the Council on **Thursday 18th May at 7.00 pm at Park Hall, Whitwick Park, off North Street, Whitwick, LE67 5HB** when there will be an opportunity to ask and answer questions.

The Council will then be able to make decisions on who to co-opt as parish councillor. The term of office will run until the next ordinary elections in May 2027.
